The Bible says that we have all fallen away and we have become corrupt; that there is no one who does good, not even one (Psalm 53:1-3). When Adam and Eve sinned, any good they did was not good in the eyes of God. He alone is perfect, completely stainless and pure. You cannot save yourself. There is no way except through Jesus Christ. Your good works are not good enough to get you to Heaven. How then can you be saved? The remedy is to repent, turn from your old life and come to Christ with a clean heart for His forgiveness (Acts 2:38).

Tonight, many gave their sicknesses to Jesus in exchange for His healing. By His supernatural power, they were free from their sicknesses. Here are some of their testimonies.

In December last year after a colonoscopy, Andrew Lee was found to have **multiple bleeding ulcers**. He was given medication for two months. The cramps did not go away. In March this year, he started coming for the Miracle Service. Last week, he went for his medical examination and it was confirmed that he was totally free of stomach ulcers.

Annie Yue had **problems with her left knee**. For a few months, she was unable to squat and had great difficulty in walking. This was her second visit to the Miracle Service. Tonight, she testified that she was 90 percent free of pain.

Lee Yuet Ho, aged 86, shared two testimonies. She had a **painful spur behind her left ear**. The doctor did not advise her to go for surgery because of her age. So instead of surgery, she has been coming to the Miracle Service for many years. Tonight, there was no more pain

but a slight itch. She also had a **lump on the left side of her body and another on her left forearm**. The Lord had miraculously removed those two lumps as well. Hallelujah!

Rajendran Ganesh Kumar Austin went to Hawaii on a business trip. On his return, he had **excruciating back pain and diarrhea** when he landed in Singapore. He went to see a doctor but to no avail. He prayed and God delivered him.

For three and a half years, Irene Chan Ai Wah had some **calcification in her breast**. Her doctor was concerned that the calcified lumps in her breast could be malignant. Praise the Lord, her last checkup showed that they were benign. Irene also **suffered a few falls** and she gave glory to God for His protection as she did not suffer any ill effects.

Seven years ago, Karen Tan-Sam had a **4 cm thyroid cyst on her neck**. Upon attending the Miracle Service twice, the thyroid cyst subsided without any medication. When she went to the specialists, they could not find any cyst.

Koh Siew Keng gave God the glory for two healings. For 18 years, she suffered from **arthritis on both hands**. God has progressively healed her and she is now about 90 percent healed. In 2012, she sustained an injury and the **disc between her L4 and L5 was missing**. Her doctor recommended surgery. However, she asked for a year's deferment. One day in 2013, she **sustained a fall and hurt her tailbone**. When an X-ray on her tailbone was done, she also asked the doctor to do an X-ray on her L4 and L5. Praise the Lord, the results showed that God had performed a creative miracle. He replaced the disc between her L4 and L5 without any surgical intervention.

This is to solve the transportation challenges faced by Lighters who are living or working in the eastern part of Singapore but are keen to attend the Thursday Upperlight. In so doing, we will help them to reduce traveling time and do away with the inconvenience of changing buses.

Besides, this implementation seeks to encourage more Lighters to participate in the church corporate prayer meeting. So let us begin to pass the good news around to fellow Lighters and gather them to take part in this important ministry of intercession. Ezekiel 22:30-31 says that we should stand in the gap to prevent the impending judgment of God.

Bus Information:

1. Pick-up time: 6.30 pm (before Upperlight) and 9.45 pm (after Upperlight)
2. Going journey pick-up point: The open space in front of Western Union at Tampines MRT station.
3. Return journey pick-up point: The open space near the fountain of Lighthouse Woodlands
4. Drop-off points:
Sengkang - Compass Point
Pasir Ris - White Sands
Tampines - MRT Station

Registration procedures:

1. You may register online at <http://www.lighthouse.org.sg/upperlightbusing.asp> or call the church office at 67881323.
2. You have to register each time you need to take the bus. Non-registered passengers will be allowed to board the bus only if there are vacant seats.
3. You can choose one-way journey from Tampines to Lighthouse Woodlands or from Lighthouse Woodlands to one of the drop-off points, or two-way journey to and fro Lighthouse Woodlands.
4. Registration cut-off time is 5.00 pm every Tuesday.
5. You need to call to cancel your registration if you cannot make it to the Upperlight. This will help us regulate the number of buses we need to book.
6. If you are taking the bus from Tampines to Lighthouse Woodlands, be at the pickup point by 6.15 pm to take attendance.
