

# MIRACLE SERVICE REPORT

Tonight, Pastor Pacer preached a salvation message titled **Saved From God's Wrath**. Many religions expound a way for mankind to be saved. The fundamental question is: what are we saved from? According to the Bible, we are not only saved from our sins and going to hell, but we are also saved from God's wrath.

Does God have the right to be angry? Is He always angry? Does He look at us as mere earthlings to torment? Pastor Pacer cited two extreme versions that people have of God. One extreme version is that God is angry all the time. He is a malicious God Who finds ways to torment us. The other extreme version is that He is a God Who is full of love, so much so that He never gets upset with us. The Bible does not show a happy or an angry God. However, there were moments in the history of Scripture that God was angry.

The God of the universe made us and gave us emotions. We were created in His image. Whether we feel sad, depressed or hopeful, these emotions come from Him. Is anger wrong? Anger is not always wrong, for we may be legitimately, justifiably angry in a matter. However, in moments of anger, we may be swayed to seek revenge. Seeking revenge is wrong because vengeance does not belong to us. It belongs to the Lord. God is perfect; therefore His emotions are always pure. When God gets angry, He does not sin. The Bible describes God as a loving God. If God is a good God, will He not get upset when He sees wrongdoings in us? We all love our family. Naturally we will be upset and angry if their safety or peace is compromised. In our anger, we may react wrongly. God is jealous for us. He wants us to know Him, to belong to Him, to come under His covering and to become His children. The problem with mankind, as described in Genesis 3, is that we are fallen creatures and sinners far from God. We have moved away from His covering and protection. We have sinned against a Holy God so He is angry with us because of our sins.

John 3:36 says that whoever believes in Jesus has eternal life; but whoever does not obey Jesus, the wrath of God remains on him. We are saved from God's wrath when we believe in Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:9 elaborates on John 3:36 – God has not destined us for wrath, punishment, condemnation or hell but salvation through Jesus. The name "Jesus" means "Yahweh saves". If you think that life has no meaning or purpose, remember that Jesus died for us so that if we believe in Him, we will know God the Father and be exempted from judgment and hell and be in Heaven when we die. Only His truth will save you. Only His power will give you life. Only the Person of Jesus will bring you salvation. Commit your life to Jesus and become His child. The wrath of God is removed when He makes us His sons and daughters.

In the healing segment, Pastor Rony shared with us on Isaiah 53:1-6. Seven hundred years ago before Jesus came into this world, the prophet Isaiah saw what was going to happen. He saw that this infinite God would be locked in time and space on earth to carry our sins and sicknesses upon Himself. If we express our faith in Him, He would save and heal us.

These six verses reveal to us not only the compassion of God for our plight, but also the condition of our hearts. If our hearts were left alone and God does not bother with us, we will all stray from Him. None of us will acknowledge God because we have a fallen nature. But God made a salvation plan for us which involved Himself. Two thousand years ago, He became a Man and carried our sins, pains, sorrows, sicknesses and diseases on the Cross. From our time perspective, He prepaid for us to receive Him. It goes the same for healing. We need to understand that Jesus already paid a costly price for us. He comes to us in the Spirit. Not only is He able to transform lives, He is also able to heal and deliver sicknesses and diseases.

Tonight, many were touched by God's healing power. Here are some of the testimonies.

Since January last year, Kwang Ah Heng **suffered from eczema on both his feet up to the knee level**. This affected his sleep. Prescribed creams and medications were unable to help him. After prayers at the Miracle Service, Ah Heng was delivered from eczema in May this year.

Joel Lam Jun Liang **sprained his right arm** because of archery training. Three weeks ago, he went back to his training after the bone alignment prayer. Praise the Lord, he was able to shoot an arrow without any pain.

In September 2014, Carole Anne Lim's son met with an accident. As a result, he suffered from brain trauma. He was **without a skull and in coma for three weeks**. Three neurosurgeons said he had very little chance of survival. A Lighter was standing in proxy for her son at the Miracle Service every Saturday. He successfully underwent a skull-cap replacement surgery. Now he is able to walk and plan his own schedule. Hallelujah!

Benny Ng was stressed because he **forgot the passwords of three folders in his computer**. He went to the Miracle Service and committed the matter to the Lord. The following day, God jogged

his memory and he was able to remember his passwords.

Janet Leong **suffered from insomnia for three months**. One month ago, she was miraculously delivered from it after prayer at the Miracle Service. Since then, every night she had uninterrupted sleep.

Richard Francis Gomez **suffered from severe migraine for 55 years**. He saw a specialist who prescribed tablets which did not work. He also tried acupuncture and traditional Chinese medicine, but to no avail. Finally, he started to attend the Miracle Service. He followed Pastor Rony's instruction by placing his hands on his temples and rebuking the migraine. He was healed two years ago. God is good!

Emily Cho was healed of **severe cough that lasted more than five years**. It was so bad that she had to use an inhaler, but God delivered her after the prayer on healing of chronic respiratory diseases at our March 21 Miracle Service.

SET A GOOD LIVING PATTERN

Life itself consists of the sum total of all your thoughts, emotions, attitudes, words and deeds.

Integrity means matching your thoughts, feelings, words and actions so that you live with congruence and without duplicity. That's authenticity without deception, guile and malice.

The greater our integrity, the greater will be our power and authority. Our integrity demonstrates a trustworthiness that stems from our character (what we are) and our competence (what we do).

Before Gandhi was assassinated, he was the voice for India. In his own quiet and unassuming ways, he addressed great multitudes as he sought for the independence of his country.

He never had a script from a speechwriter. He spoke extemporaneously. This frail-looking man could hold a crowd spellbound for several hours. When he spoke, the whole nation listened attentively, including his enemies. He lived with great integrity and spoke with great conviction.

Journalists from all over the world wanted to know how he could ever do that. One day, one of Gandhi's closest aides explained to a group of curious journalists, "What Gandhi thinks is what he feels, what he feels is what he says and what he says is what he does. What he thinks, feels, says and does are all the same. They all match. There is congruence in his living. Hence, there is such a power in his life."

Once, Gandhi boarded a train. As his train was pulling away, a reporter, on the platform of the railway station, shouted a question at him, "Do you have a message for the people?"

Gandhi gave him a short message, "My life is my message."

We can also put it the other way round: "His message is his life." They are one and the same. His thoughts, words and deeds are integrated. They are interwoven into an entity of wholeness. That is integrity.

If you want to live a purposeful and influential life, hold on to your God-given vision. Don't give it up. Live a simple and structured life. To achieve it, have a healthy routine that ensures consistency and reliability, free from unnecessary frills and fancies, pomp and ceremonies.

Always be true to God and to yourself. Then you will have no difficulty being true to others, especially those you love.

The last part of Edgar Guest's poem "Am I True To Myself?" reads:

*I never can hide myself from me,

I know what others may never know,  
I never can fool myself -- and so,  
Whatever happens, I want to be  
Self-respecting and conscience free.*
