*"Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool."*

It is indeed heartwarming to know that the Almighty God cares to commune and reason with us. In Isaiah 1:18 (KJV), God is speaking to you, "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." This was the essence of Pastor Rony's inspiring message, **God Reasons With You**.

Usually, the most effective way to help a wayward child is to sit down and reason out with the youngster on where he or she has gone wrong and how to get on the right path. In the same way, our Heavenly Father wants to reason together and tell us how to do it right when we go the wrong way. The reason is because God is not willing that any person should perish in sin, but all will come to His saving grace.

The Bible clearly states that all have sinned and come short of the standard of God. Be he king or pauper, be he rich or poor, every one of us sins. And the punishment of sin is eternal death. In ourselves, we are helpless and hopeless, lacking the strength to overcome sins and temptations. Therefore, we are in need of God's forgiveness and liberty from the bondage of sin. The devil

holds people in sin and bad habits, thus separating them from a holy and righteous God. To deliver you from this predicament, God reasons and offers you the only one way and that is through Jesus Christ.

In John 14:6, Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." Here we find that Jesus is the only way. So He came 2,000 years ago to pave the way for us to be on the right path leading to Heaven. For this reason, He sacrificed His life on the Cross of Calvary. Let us consider Isaiah 53:3-8 (GNT) to know the truth of the matter. Whilst we were yet sinners and rejected Him, He endured suffering and pain. No one would even look at Him as we despised and ignored Him as if He were nothing. Here we find Jesus bled and died on the Cross, paying the price for all our sins even before we were born into this world. To redeem mankind from the penalty of sin, He endured the suffering that should have been ours and the pain that we should have borne. And all the while we thought that His suffering was punishment sent by God. But it is because of our sins, He was wounded and beaten for the evil we did (verses 3-4). The Bible tells us that the Roman soldier whipped Jesus 39 times on His bare back until it was lacerated. By the punishment and blows He received and suffered on our behalf, we are healed and made whole from sicknesses (verses 5-6). His precious blood shed on the Cross cleanses us from all sin and we receive forgiveness when we repent and accept Jesus as Lord and Savior.

In other words, our sin has made Jesus, Who has no sin, a criminal to die on the Cross. He took our place as the sin-bearer of mankind. Just think of it, the Son of God would subject Himself even to death on the Cross to redeem us because we cannot save ourselves from eternal death and hell. That is the greatest unconditional love of God Who longs to reason with you whatever state you are in.

Besides, today we do not need an animal sacrifice for sin like in the Old Testament. God deals with us personally and directly through Jesus Christ, the Sacrificial Lamb of God. Christ had paid the gruesome price to salvage us from sin once and for all (verses 7-8). They buried Him in a tomb, but on the

third day He rose again because death and grave could not hold Him. Jesus had risen and is alive! Unlike all the religions of the world, the Originator of Christianity lives forevermore.

We may not understand it all because our natural mind is finite, but God is infinite and unending. Therefore, do not wait till you understand everything before receiving Christ as your personal Savior. Whatever your response may be, it does not change the truth that Jesus is the one and only way to everlasting life.

When we consider the great salvation God personally brought to us through Christ, it is definitely not an airy-fairy faith, but the incredible Gospel truth. Today is the day of salvation! If there is a tugging in your heart, do not reject the mercy and love of God extended to you. Be in touch with this awesome God and allow Him to reason together with you for a brand-new life.

Truly, God is merciful and is still healing people today. However, the greatest miracle in this world is the healing of the sin-sick soul. Tonight, we rejoiced with precious souls who were enlightened by the Word of God and came forth to receive Jesus as Lord and Savior. Also, many others were miraculously healed by the unlimited power of God. Here are some testimonies for the glory of God:

This year before the Lunar New Year, Susan Lee **suffered piles which ruptured and was oozing blood**. She consulted a specialist and was given some medication, but he recommended surgery. She came to the Miracle Service to pray for healing. She also garnered prayer support from church friends. After that, the bleeding stopped and the piles healed without surgery. Praise God!

Peter Teo shared a belated testimony and praised God for healing him. He had **arthritis and suffered pain for 20 years**. However, he came to pray and trust God for healing.

Besides, he also had **thyroid for three years**. However, two years ago he was healed of thyroid. Then he received healing of his arthritis condition as well. Since there was no more pain, medication was not needed anymore. Last year, the doctor confirmed that he was completely cleared of the two conditions.

Five years ago, Raymond Wong **underwent cataract surgery**. Three months ago, he **developed blurred vision in his left eye**. Last Saturday after prayer, he discovered that his left eye could see clearly from afar. Standing on stage tonight, he could tell the time on the clock, which was at a distance across the Sanctuary, correctly. Hallelujah!

Irene Chan suffered **hypertension since 2006**. The doctor indicated that she could not be without medication because her systolic blood pressure reading was 190, far above the ideal reading of 120. She had been praying for healing. Earlier today, she was told by the doctor that her systolic reading had gone down to 115 and she did not need medication anymore. Also, she was successful in the flat selection process. She was placed number one in the long queue. She thanked God for what He has done!

For two weeks, Alice Too suffered much **pain on her left arm**. As a result, she **could not stretch or lift up her arm**. The doctor indicated that it was due to the symptoms of **frozen shoulder**. She was instantly healed by God after a Gospelighter prayed for her. She was then able to lift up her arm high with no more pain!

Tan Ah Poh, aged 63, had a **fall three months ago and hurt her left pelvis down to the thigh**. She comes to the Miracle Service regularly. More than a month ago, she received progressive healing and 50% of the pain was gone. Tonight, after prayer, she was completely healed with no more pain. She demonstrated her healing by walking gingerly without the aid of a walking stick. Glory to God!

## RECONCILIATION BETWEEN JACOB AND ESAU

What followed next was indeed high drama! As Esau came near, he dismounted, ran and met his younger brother. They embraced, and Esau fell on his neck and kissed him. And they both wept. Forgiveness and love flowed freely.

Some things cannot be explained, they have to be experienced. Can you ever explain the unbelievable effects of a breakthrough prayer, such as the one that Jacob had experienced? Could a man with deep-seated hatred and anger, and so bent on revenge, be turned around to offer total forgiveness and love? Yet that was exactly what happened to Esau.

Could a covetous man like Jacob be so transformed that he was prepared to make a complete restitution for everything he had gained by dubious means and with everything he had earned through blood, sweat and tears? Yet that was exactly what happened to Jacob.

When you know your position in Christ and press through, something powerful will happen. Think of your pressing needs right now. Are you in an impossible position? Are you trapped in some kind of a bondage? Do you need to change your adverse circumstances?

If your answer is "yes", you need to come face to face with God at Peniel, just like Jacob did. Stop running and let God deal with you, deeply and thoroughly, before you can begin to control your outward circumstances.

Let a transformation take place deep inside you. Take a day off from work and seek the face of God. Stay there in the closet until a breakthrough comes.

## RECONCILIATION BETWEEN JOSEPH AND HIS BROTHERS

While the two brothers embraced each other in tears, little Joseph was watching the touching drama. Little did he realize that many years later, he would also be playing a starring role in a drama of brotherly reconciliation.

Young Joseph was sold as a slave to Egypt by his own jealous brothers. While in a strange, foreign land, he walked and talked like a prince because he knew his God intimately.

When your self-image is that of a prince, you cannot help but behave like one. Very soon, he actually became one through a miracle of God. No other Egyptian was above him except the Pharaoh. So awesome was his power and position in Egypt that he was given control over all the foodstuff in that land.

For survival, his brothers came by to purchase food. That was when the most touching reconciliation took place. When that happened, I wonder if Joseph had looked back, through the passage of time, to that day when his father had that teary reconciliation with his uncle, Esau.

Finally, Joseph revealed his identity to his brothers. Immediately, they hit the floor and trembled. There was no better time for Joseph to take revenge and have them executed.

However, Joseph (powerful as he was) acted like a noble prince. Crying profusely, he comforted them, "You intended evil toward me but God turned it around for good."

After the reconciliation, Jacob entered into Canaan, the land that God had promised to give to his descendants. It was not his yet, but he stepped into it by faith.
