TODAY AND EXPERIENCE  
HIS TRANSFORMING POWER.



In a sobering message, Pastor Rony highlighted these important words: **OFFENSE, UNFORGIVENESS AND UNBELIEF**. These three emotions are interlinked and will lead to the fourth that is unwellness.

It always begins with offense. In Luke 17:1, Jesus says that it is impossible to live this life without offense. Sometimes we may hurt people and at other times people may hurt us. As Christians, we learn not to offend people as far as possible. But at times when you need to deal with a recalcitrant, he may feel offended no matter how well you put yourself across. Besides, even a Christian or a revered saint still gets offended naturally. So it is important to know how to get over an offense. This is because an offense undealt with will somehow lead to unforgiveness which in turn will cause unbelief in God's promises. And unbelief will lead to unwellness. Hence, it will become a big hindrance to one's salvation and healing.

Interestingly, John the Baptist, the forerunner of Jesus Christ, had doubts when he was thrown into prison for preaching repentance. Although he was a fiery servant of God, in his lowest moment, he doubted that Jesus is the Messiah. John sent his disciples to ask Jesus, "Are You the Messiah or should we look for someone

else?" To this, Jesus merely told John's disciples to tell him all the miraculous works that were happening. Recorded in Matthew 11:5-6 (KJV), we read that the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised up and the poor have the Gospel preached to them. Then in verse 6, Jesus said, "And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me." What did Jesus mean?

It simply means that if Jesus had healed the sick, cast out demons and raised the dead, then who would be offended by Him? Firstly, Jesus was referring to the religious leaders. They were offended because they felt threatened when the whole country went after Jesus, believing in the miraculous works He did. Next, Jesus was referring to those people who could not comprehend His true identity. Their puny minds could not perceive His divinity as much as His humanity, especially those from His home town who saw Him grow up like any other child in their community. They were rather offended at His popularity and power to heal and deliver the people. So when people believed Jesus as the Son of God, they were offended because they regarded Him as a mere human and overlooked His divinity.

In Mark 6:1-6 (KJV), we find Jesus came to His home town in Nazareth. When he was teaching in the synagogue, many were astonished by His teachings. They wondered how He had such powerful wisdom and knowledge and how He had done mighty works supernaturally. And they asked, "Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon?" And they took offense at Him because they were blinded to His divinity (verse 3). The truth is Christ is God incarnated Who took the form of flesh and blood to identify Himself with mankind. God sent Him to be born into the world in order to die on the Cross to redeem us from sin and eternal damnation.

Hence, Jesus could not do any miracles particularly in Nazareth. But in every other town He went, tremendous miracles happened. Think of it, the same Son of God with the same power and anointing was hindered to

do miracles there, except that He laid hands on some with minor illnesses. So Jesus marveled at their unbelief (verse 6). How much He longed to heal them all but because of their offense and unbelief, they could not receive. What a blunder! They could have enjoyed health and wellness if only they believed.

Friend, pay attention to your heart! The Bible warns us to guard our heart with all diligence, for out of it are the issues of life. When we are offended, the heart is affected because it harbors unforgiveness and unbelief. So whatever offense you may have, it is imperative to forgive so that it will not hinder your salvation and healing. Allow Christ to come into your heart today and experience His transforming power. With Jesus residing in your heart, you can rise up victoriously and be in right standing with God and man. He will empower you to overcome offense, unforgiveness and unbelief. Then unwellness will flee away. Let Jesus marvel at your faith instead and live in wellness before the New Year dawns!

Before the healing segment, Pastor encouraged us to focus on the word, 'Receive'. Take for example, on Christmas, when you are given a gift, it is tangible to receive it. But if you do not receive it, then it is not yours. So when a gift is given, you either receive or reject it. However, the biblical perspective of receiving from God is much deeper. That is, you need to act by faith and believe you have received the answer to prayer already even though you do not see it yet. The very words of Jesus in Mark 11:24 says, "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." Here you are assured according to God's Word that when you believe and stake your claim to receive it in Jesus' name, it shall come to pass!

Tonight, God sent His living Word and convicted many people in our midst. Precious souls came willingly to receive Christ into their hearts. Numerous received healing when they believed.

Here are some who testified:

Florence Soh suffered from *erratic heart condition for 10 long years*. Even after surgery, it did not improve. So the doctor recommended a second operation. But she chose to trust God for healing and came for prayer. Now her condition has improved. Next, she had a *high cancer marker of the pancreas*. Through prayer, it returned to normal and she was healed. She also thanked God for helping her *keep her job which she almost lost*. Praise God for His mercy and grace!

Esther Lam praised God for His divine protection. *Her husband had a serious heart problem with three blocked arteries*. Since he had to undergo surgery, she came to pray and believed God to heal and preserve him. During the surgery, something went amiss. Despite that, her husband came out of it safe and well. She thanked God for answering prayers and sustaining her husband through the ordeal.

Philip Josephine testified that *her brother had a serious fall four months ago*. As a result, *his brain was seriously affected and the doctor gave him 12 hours to live*. She had been praying regularly at the Miracle Service and the Thursday prayer meetings. Through prayers, she received faith to believe that God would preserve her brother's life. Meanwhile, her brother had been in and out of the ICU in hospital. Amazingly, last Thursday, he was discharged and fully conscious. Praise Jesus!

Angela Yap shared that on the *19th week of her pregnancy, a scan showed that the baby had a congenital heart condition*. Believing God for healing, she came for prayers at the Miracle Service. Then on the 22nd week, another scan was done and she was informed that the baby was alright. Five months ago, her baby was born perfectly normal. Hallelujah!

*But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them-- yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me.*

Not long ago, Lori and I thought it would be nice to have a little tomato garden in our backyard – nothing big, just a few plants. So, here's what we didn't do. When it was time to prepare the ground, we didn't. When it was time to plant the seeds, we didn't. When it was time to weed and water, we didn't. Then, one day, we stood out on our back deck, looked at the place where the garden was supposed to be, and said, "Hey, God where are all the tomatoes!?"

I know, it's ridiculous to think that without plowing, planting, weeding, and watering that somehow "by God's grace" tomato plants are going to appear. It's just as ridiculous to think that we can grow spiritually without reading the **Bible**, become worshipers without ever worshiping, connect with other believers without reaching out to other believers, serve while sitting, and share the message of Jesus without opening our mouths.
