如果没有宣教工作所流的汗；甚至流血流泪，到处为主发光，今天世界各角落的基督徒会不会寥寥可数呢？如果每个基督徒回顾过去所得的永恒救恩，我想直接或间接都得归功于宣教的努力，当然全都得归于主耶稣基督所赐的恩典！

本身曾在1978年12月份的一个晚上，一脚步一脚步的踏进了当年的加冷体育馆，出席了来自美国的葛培理布道会。回顾40年前的壮观和动人场面至今仍然深刻脑海；烙印心中。五个晚上的布道会，见证了五个晚上的神同在！我就在其中一晚毫无挣扎与保留的接受了耶稣救主直到今天。

感谢主的恩典，在2007年时有机会参与了葛培理布道团在本区域的一个‘我的希望My Hope’宣教活动而跑尽印尼与马来西亚的多数城镇和教会。感谢主！这耗巨资人力的宣教计划让数以千计的灵魂得拯救！

今年2月22日，这位享年99岁的伟大布道家葛培理牧师在北卡罗莱纳安详的蒙主恩召。他赢得了世人对他的多个尊贵称呼，包括：“历史上布道人数最多的布道家”。

其实，这位美国北卡罗莱纳养牛场土生土长的宣教士还有另一个别具心意的称呼：“中国女婿”。原来他的爱妻路得是在中国的淮安出世。太太的父亲，即他的岳父是早年曾在中国宣教（1916-1941）的美国长老会宣教士钟爱华医师（Lemuel Nelson Bell）。

钟爱华在中国宣教25年，多次面临生死抉择，而他每一次都顺从上帝的引导。他曾受访时说上帝为他所安排的地方就是最安全、最稳妥之地。在一次美国的电视采访中，钟爱华和妻子被问到是否觉得当年在中国的时间是浪费生命。他回答说改天能和大伙在天家相见是多么有意义的一份工作。

钟爱华的外孙，即葛培理之子葛福临（Franklin Graham）也曾多次访问过中国。2008年，当四川汶川发生大地震时，葛福临作为葛培理布道团的领袖

This evening, Pastor Rony inspired our faith in God through his powerful message entitled **Catch the Words of Jesus**. A lot of biblical truths must be caught in the spirit. How do you catch the Word of God? It is when you hear the Word of God that pertains to your need. You are so eager to have your need met by God that you will do anything according to what His Word says.

When the disciples were in a boat on the lake early in the morning, they were struggling to make headway because of contrary winds. Jesus came to them at the right time, walking on water. The disciples screamed because they thought He was a ghost, but they recognised Him when He came nearer. Peter was looking at Jesus with awe and wanted to be like Him. He was waiting for a word to catch and Jesus said "Come!" and Peter jumped into the water based on that one word because he had caught it from Jesus in his heart and spirit. As a result, a miracle happened. Peter was able to walk on water.
