
COPING WITH GRIEF WORKSHOP

This evening, Pastor Rony declared that **There's Much More Than This Life**. The Word of God tells us that life is much more than from cradle to grave. Life is cradle, grave and eternity; and eternity is unending life.

Many people see physical death as the defining line that marks the end of life. However, the Bible tells us that physical death is not the end of life. Physical death is like the horizon that we see from the seashore. We see the horizon that seems to mark the end of the sea, but it is truly only an imaginary line. As we sail out into the sea and move nearer to the horizon, we realise that we will never reach it as there is much more beyond the horizon. Similarly, we will realise that there is much more beyond physical death. There is eternal life after physical death.

Pastor Rony shared Jesus' parable of Lazarus and the rich man recorded in Luke 16:19-31. A poor beggar named Lazarus had no home and no health. He begged outside a rich man's gate and yearned to be fed with crumbs. And he only had the company of some dogs which licked the oozing sores that covered his body. One day, Lazarus died, and he went straight to Heaven into the eternal comfort of God. Most people would have looked at Lazarus' broken-down body, found his life pitiful and concluded that he had a sorry end. Little did they know that behind the scenes, life went on and Lazarus is now comforted in God's presence forever.

On the other hand, the rich man lived sumptuously and to himself. He did not care for the poor and very likely did not know God. One day, the rich man died and found himself in the torment of hell. Most people would have looked at the rich man's

prosperous life and concluded that he had a great life and a good end. However, life went on after physical death and he is now in torment forever.

It is a terrible thing to be thrown into eternity without Christ. Our only hope is in Christ as He died for our sins and whoever believes in Him would be saved. We have all sinned and fall short of the glory of God. When we believe in Jesus as our Lord and Saviour through faith, He pronounces us forgiven, saved and born again into the Kingdom of God of eternal joy.

Life is more than what we see and all of us are moving towards eternity. Whether we are prepared or not, all of us would die one day and find ourselves either in eternal joy or eternal torment. From the cradle to the grave, we are given the chance to make the right choice. All of us move into eternity after our physical death. We need to make the most important decision in life to receive Jesus as our Lord and Saviour and walk in His ways.
